#### 11.06.01 Apologies for Absence

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**Resolved:** that the apologies for absence received from Cllr. J. Kershaw (family illness) D. Watkinson (unwell) be agreed.

## 11.06.02 Public Open Session

The meeting commenced with a 15 minute session during which members of the public had the opportunity to raise questions and seek clarification in relation to village and community matters.

Mr. P. Ashton from Moulton Adventure Group outlined details of a planning application shortly to be submitted to site a container for storage at the Group's HQ in School Lane. Noted the details and that this would be considered by the Parish Council under the usual consultation process. Other matters raised were:

- branches of an oak tree are overhanging the pavement in Niddries Lane

- the new 30mph sign in Jack Lane is obliterated by tree branches
- various hedges were identified as overhanging pavements
- various highways issues as identified from correspondence from a resident

PCSO Kat Stock submitted her latest report, including reference to a small fire at the play area.

## Resolved: that

a) the Clerk's report relating to progress on a number of current matters be received;

- b) arising from the report it was noted that:
  - Cllr. Watson (CWAC) had met with Highways Officers concerning the state of the road surface at the Beehive Roundabout and safety issues at junction on Jack Lane onto the by-pass action to undertake repairs to the former are in hand but no scheme to alter the junction at the latter will be undertaken. A review of this will be requested.
  - English Heritage has advised that the farmer has been approached to put the area of the barrow in the Natural England Stewardship Scheme and that the erection of a notice regarding its location would be helpful Cllr. Rigby will contact the farmer to pursue this
  - the Mid-Cheshire Footpath Society can help but need to be advised of any paths which are not being maintained, support a village walk of footpaths and invite subscription to the Society – Cllrs. Bowie and Wood to work on organising a first joint Parishes walk
  - Cllr. Burgess and Cllr. Bowie will attend Cheshire West and Chester Council's Rural Conference at Oulton Park on 23<sup>rd</sup> June and The Localism Bill seminar at Crewe on 29<sup>th</sup> June, respectively
  - an update on progress of the pilot scheme for electronic consultation on planning applications for Local Councils has been received; it is being trialed with a Town Council before being rolled out to other pilot Councils
  - Debbie Bennett, the Council's appointed School Governor will give a brief report to the next meeting
  - the Council will have a stall at the Crow Fair.
